Major Woolfard from the Committee of Laws Delivered W. Speaker.

A Bill ascertaining the gage of Tob. h. d. and to prevent crossing, cutting
and defacing Tob. taken on boards Shoppes and Vessells upon Freight which
was read the first time and Comitted to the Committee of Laws for amend-
ment.

The house proceeds to tax fees on the severall bills private following vizt
To the Honble the Speaker for the private Bill for reuniting new parshun-
dred to King and Queens Parish in St. Maries County the sume of twelve
hundred pounds of Tob. and to Thomas Maenemara Clerk the sume
of six hundred pounds of Tobacco to be paid by y^e Vestry men of
King and Queens Parish in Saint Marys County.

To the Honble Speaker for the bill making valid Wm Lunn's deed to
Thomas Larkin the sume of forty Shillings and to Thomas Maenemara
Clerke the sume of twenty Shillings. Ordered the said Larkin pay the
same.

To the Honble Speaker for the Bill supplying defects in the Conveying of
Lands from Brand to Wright & from Wright to Chambers the sume
of forty Shillings and to Tho. Maenemara Clk. the sume of twenty
Shillings, Ordered to be paid by the said Chambers.

To the Honble the Speaker for the bill for the Naturalization of Thomas
Hervey the sum of twenty five Shillings and to Thomas Maenemara
Clk. the sume of ten Shillings, ordered to be paid by said Hervey.

To the Honble Speaker for the Bill about the Kentish House brought in
in favour of the Rector Gov. and Visitors of free schools the sume of three
pounds and to Thomas Maenemara the sume of thirty Shillings,
ordered to be paid by the said Rector Gov. & Visitors of free school.

To the Honble the Speaker for the Bill in supplying a defect in y^e last
will and testament of Raphael Hayward and for setting
in Robert Scott Clarke and Charles Neale Planters the sume
hundred pounds of Tobacco and to Tho. Maenemara
sume of six hundred pounds of Tobacco ordered to be paid
Scott and Neale.
