Upon reading the message from the Lower house by W^m Tyler and of praying a Conference to be had relating to the Laws and the style used when the Lord Prop^rs noble ancestors had the Government of this Province. We have resolved that the said Conference be granted and that the Hon^{ble} Thomas Brooke Esq. Col^l W^m Halland Col^l Thomas Addison, Philemon Loyd Esq. Lt Col^l Rich^d Tilghman and Col^l Thomas Smith be appointed to confer with the Conferees to be named by the Lower house at six of the clock this evening at W^m Dadds house on that Subject.
