

hereby granted him, and in Consideration of the pains Labour and  
trouble he shall take in the due Execution thereof.  
Authorise Direct and Empower him to take Receive and Retain  
to and for his own use out of all such Moneyd &c. or other Effects as  
shall be received on any of the accounts aforesaid except for the duty arising  
by the Exportation of Tobacco, being two Shillings and Nine pence per lb.  
and the duty arising by the Tonnage on Ships being fourteen pence per ton  
the sum of ten pounds in the hundred and so from Rate for a greater  
or lesser quantity over and above the Gallanys so aforesaid to be allowed  
his officers and for receiving and remitting the said two & nine pence  
per lb. and fourteen pence per ton, the same of one hundred pounds  
sterling yearly. And we do hereby Revoke annall and make void  
all former and other Comissions powers and Authorityes touching  
the前述 by us or in Authority to any person or persons heretofore so  
granted ratifying & Confirming all whatsoever has been lawfully  
done by the said Charles Carroll by virtue of my late Lord Benedict's  
letter to him as far as in us lyed as also what after his death shall be lawfully  
lawfully done by virtue of our letter to him.

And this our Commission to him and the powers hereby granted to continue  
in force during our pleasure and no longer.
