A Bill directing the Manner of Electing and Summoning delegates and
representatives to serve in succeeding Assemblies and for Ascertaining the
Expenses of the Council Delegates of Assembly and Commissioners of the
Provincial and County Courts of this Province which, was read the
first time and Ordered a Second reading to-morrow in the
afternoon.

Whereas this House has been informed that some persons
(vizt.) Edward Coyle and William Fitzredmond both of Annapolis
have been in the custody of the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County till they
should pay some fines on them inflicted for some Unreasonable
Practices they were found guilty of against his Sacred Majesty King
George and that the same persons were discharged unduly. It is
Ordered that the Sheriff appear before the Barr of this house and
show by what authority he discharged them.

Whereupon the Sheriff appeared before the barr of this House and
produced two Receipts from under the hands of Charles Carroll Esq.
acknowledging the receipt of the said fines from the said persons only
which they were set at large which Receipts were ordered to be entered as
follows (vizt.)
