

10. th Enrolled Bill for confirming and making valid in law a conveyance of lands made by Anthony Myrtone his wife lately decess'd to Rich^d. More & Edith his wife of Queen Anne's County.
11. th Enrolled Bill ascertaining the Gauge & Tare of Salt Hoggsheds and to prevent trespassing and defacing the same &c.
12. th Enrolled Bill confirming a conveyance of land made by Joseph Bridger decess'd to Thomas Jones decess'd.
13. th Enrolled Bill confirming a conveyance of lands made by Anthony Myrtone and Anne his wife to W^m. Little.
14. th Enrolled Bill confirming 3 tracts of lands in Armandell County to Susannah Johnson and her heirs &c.
15. th Enrolled Bill repealing an act res^t. striking off Fines.
16. th Enrolled Bill permitting the Inhabitants of this Province to sue out writs when Plaintiffs and appear and give Jud^g. when Def^s in the General Courts thereof in their own proper persons.
17. th Enrolled Bill to restrain the ill practices used by Sheriffs in taking goods by fire fact and selling them by conditione Respon^s.
18. th Enrolled Bill for repairing the damages already sustained in the Records of the Land Secretaries, Comptrol^{rs}, and County Court Officers & for the security of the same Records for the future.
19. th Enrolled Bill for the better security of the peace and safety of his Lord's Government and the Protestant Interest within this Province.
20. th Enrolled Bill for confirming his Lordship's acceptance of the 18th ph^r. formerly raised.
21. th Enrolled Bill Empowering a Committee to Lay the Publick Levy for the year 1716.

After which his Re^{py} the Governour was pleased to declare that with the advice of the R^t. Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^r Council of State of this Province he thought fitt to prorogue this Present General Assembly till the tenth day of October next, to which time the same was accordingly prorogued.

Afterwards M^r. Speaker with the rest of the Members of the Lower House returned to their own house, and then M^r. Speaker resumed the Chair and Reported to the House that his Re^{py} the Governour with the advice of the R^t. Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^r Council of State in this Province had prorogued this Present General Assembly to the tenth day of October next to which time this House accordingly prorogues itself so Endeth this first Session of Assembly held for this Province after the King was graciously pleased to restore the Right Hon^{ble} the Prop^r to the Government of this Province this tenth day of August 1716.
