Whereas by a certain act of Assembly ascertaining  
the bounds of Land within this Province It is enacted that all  
Persons who find themselves aggrieved by the sentence of any  
Court of and Concurred the bounds of their Lands may lay  
application to his Excellency the Governor of this Province obtain  
a Commission of Review to Enquire into and Examine again
