Who the same day represent it as an acquaintance that a  
great number of the inhabitants of this Province have been  
Subpoened to appear at the High Court of Chancery to answer  
the Bill of Complaint of Maurice Bishop Esq; upon a  
suggestion that they were indebted to a certain John Goodwin and  
other Merchants in London before making any demand or  
giving notice of such their claime some of which never had  
any dealing with the Merchants they are charged Debtors to  
them have been charged Debtors instead of Debtors and many  
of them Debtors did by the said Merchants own accounts owe  
but very small and trifling sumes short of one pound which  
by the Laws of the Land are not cognizable in the Chancery  
Court notwithstanding which such persons have been obliged  
to make and sue and defend their suits to their great expence  
and neglect of their business in attendance of Courts and when  
on a hearing the greatness of their offences by such severe  
prosecutions have been made against them have been dismissed  
the Court but could recover no costs at the said Bishop's suit -
