Ordered a second reading to morrow morning and in the mean time to lye on the table for further consideration.

A Supplementary bill to the act for the appointment of Constables &c. was read the first time and Ordered a second reading in the afternoon.

Ordered that the act for the Encouraging Tillage and relief of poor Debtors to be revived.

On reading the report of the Committee of Aggrievances referred from last sessions against the cutting of entails of Lands.

Ordered the Committee of Laws prepare a bill to prevent the like for the future. And that Mr. Brannock be added to the Committee on that occasion.

The Petition of M. Evan Jones relating to the Post office is referred till next sessions. The House adjourns till one o'clock in the afternoon.

Costs Meridien, The House meet according to adjournment.

Supplementary bill to the act for appointment of Constables was read the second time by special order and the question being put whether the same shall pass as it now is or be amended.

Resolved it pass as it now is. Thereupon this Bill will pass which was so endorsed, and sent to the upper house by Mr. Taylor and Capt. Fairley. They return and say they Decieve it.

Ordered the Committee of Laws prepare a bill against buying, selling, farming or giving or taking of Gratuities for offices.

Ordered that the Committee of Aggrievances inspect the act of Limitation of Officers fees and make their report thereon to this House and Ordered that Capt. Codd Col. Maxwell Mr. Walter Smith Major Emerson & Capt. Colgate be added to the Committee.

The bill to prevent the cutting off entails within this province was read the first time and Ordered a second reading to morrow.

The House adjourns till to morrow morning eight a clock.

The House meet according to adjournment, Yesterdays proceedings are read. Bill for the Relief of Languishing prisoners, read againe and referred for further consideration till next sessions of Assembly.

Supplementary bill to the act for causing Grand and Pett. Jurors and witnesses to come to the Prov^l and County Courts and ascertaining their allowances was read the first and second times by special order and will pass which was so endorsed.

Bill to prevent the cutting of entails was read the second time and will pass which was so endorsed.
