Esq. Loyds from his Excellency delivers (W. Speaker the following
Message, Viz: - June 6th 1719.

W. Speaker - I Desire you will acquaint the House that
I have just received the Message by Col. Mackall and five more,
Desiring my Acceptance of two hundred pounds Current Money for the
good Offices I have done the Country - I am willing to accept of
that Sum as a Reimbursement of what I have really and truly
expended (tho' the Sum I have given for exceeds this now offered) for
Supporting and Maintaining the Laws of this Province from the
Invasion of the Papists and their adherents on them, and not as a
Present from the Country - and this I give under my hand because
I am now and at all times ready to maintain the truth of what
I say that Honour and Safety of Maryland was at Stake at the
time I laid down my Money to defend both -

May it please Your Excellency,

We are truly sensible that your Excellency has
been at Great Expense in Maintaining the Laws of the Province

your Excellency's Acceptance of it as such.
