The petition of St. Ann's Vestry read and referred till next Session. The petition of Richard Cole and Mary his wife read and referred till next Session, and ordered the parties concerned have notice thereof.

The petition of the Vestry of William and Mary Parish in Charles County is referred till next Session.

This House having taken into Consideration Col^o Samuel Blount Treasurer of the Western Shore his Letter desiring he may have an order to dispose of Sundry bills of Exchange for Money.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Eastern Shore and Western Shore dispose of such bills of Exchange they now have in their hands or shall hereafter have due to the publick to the best advantage they can for Money for the use of the Province and that they render a particular account of what bills they shall negotiate to whom paid away and for how much of sent to the Committee for laying the publick Levy or the next Session of assembly which shall first happen (reserving only so much as will discharge the Countys Sterling debts in Bills of Exchange.

The petition of John Kirk complaining of the Land Commissioners of Dorchester County was read and rejected.
