Treasurer of this Province to the use of His Lordship without any
deduction if he shall afterwards signify his approbation &
thereof but if his dissent be signified thereto then that it shall be
applied to the use of the publick in such manner as the General
assembly shall hereafter appoint which with the amendment
above proposed will pass.
