

and so, every year successively who shall be commissioned by the
 Governor, for the time being as above (and being so commissioned
 shall act in all appeals upon notice given them by the party appe-
 aling at the next County Court, after the Determination of the first
 View who upon such notice given shall appoint a time (not less
 then three weeks) to meet at the said in dispute, and then give due
 notice to all persons concerned, (and proceed to hear and determine the
 dispute, and give judgment thereon, which judgment shall be
 final, and that their Commission shall continue and year
 and no longer, and so every Election successively for such Commissions
 and that they do give Publick notice thereof as usual in Election of
 Delegates & Officers and that every Commission accepting the Com-
 mission, & qualifying himself upon none attendance at the premises
 at time appointed, shall be liable to a fine of five hundred Pounds
 Tobacco, as well as, each Commissioners an failure as aforesaid
 at the first View unless reasonable cause be shown to the Commissions
 present for his absence, and that all the petitions to this assembly
 be lived by a clause, to be added to this bill to prove the Benefits of
 this appeal has provided - And that each Commissioners have
 one hundred Pounds, of Tobacco, for each day he shall attend
 at the said in dispute, - The committee consisting some members
 Inclinable to lay down certain Rules for the Commissions to act by
 Mr. Speaker to resume the Chair and put the question whether Rules
 for the Commissions to act by shall be prescribed or not Accordingly
 Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair and an motion whether Rules, shall
 be laid down in the Law, for the Commissions to act by or not. It is
 Carried in the negative by the majority of Votes - Resolved that in
 Case, any of the Commissions, shall die, be interested or Related to
 either party, Consisting that those the Commissions or Commissions
 surviving not interested or Related to either party (with the approbation
 of the parties contending make choice of another person or persons
 wanting to supply the room of such Commissions or Commissions
 so deceased, interested or Related But in Case the parties contending
 cannot or will not agree to the choice of such other person as,
 aforesaid the surviving not interested or Related Commissions or
 Commissions, here or themselves, be empowered to make the choice
 Ordered that a message be prepared, as follows Viz
