

of them a freeholder to be elected by the majority of the freeholders
in each County, on the second Day of next November Court and
so every year successively, who upon a Representation of such their
Election from the Sheriff are to be Commissions by the Governor for
the time being, that appeals be granted and that three persons, in
each County be elected in manner aforesaid at the time aforesaid
whom the other Commissions are elected to be and to be Commissions
as above and to receive all such appeals, as upon notice given thereby
the party appealing at the next County Court after the Determination
on of the first, View, shall come before them and upon such notice
given them to appoint a time (not less than three Weeks) afterwards
to meet on the Lands in Dispute, and there to give due notice thereof
to all persons concerned, at which time so to be appointed they may
proceed to hear and Determine the Dispute, and Give Judgment
thereon which Judgment shall be final that the several Commissions
shall continue but for one year That the Sheriff give Publick
notice of the Elections as usual in Electing Delegates & Officers
That every Commission according to the Commission and
qualifying himself as a Commission and shall afterwards
refuse to give his Attendance as a Commission as a
Dispute, that shall lay properly before him, shall be fined five
hundred Pounds of Tobacco, to the use of the free Schools in
the several Counties, unless reasonable cause to be shown to the
contrary to be allowed by the Commissions, That the several
Petitioners to the Assembly be Relieved by a Clause to be added to
the Bill by giving them the Benefits of the Appeal here provided
That each Commission on both Commissions be allowed one
hundred pounds of Tobacco for every day they shall attend on
the Law in Dispute, That all of the Commissions who have been
formerly Commissions on the first Survey be again Commissions
on the appeal, That in case any of the Commissions shall
die during the continuance of their Commission or be interested
in the Dispute, or related to the contending parties That then
the Commissions or Commissions so surviving not interested
or Related with the Appraiser of the parties concerned, may
make choice of some other persons to supply such vacancy but
in case the contending Parties will not joyne or cannot agree to
the choice of such other person as aforesaid That then such
Commissions or Commissions qualified as aforesaid shall
be empowered to make the choice
