 with the report they return and say they have delivered their Message  
 to the Upper House from the Lower House delivers Mr Speaker the  
 Bill for Relief of Richard Thatcher and Peter Mayne thus Endorsed  
 By the Upper House of Assembly Oct. 21. 1720  
 Upon reading the within Bill and the humble petition and  
 representation of Daniel Oulany on the behalf of the In-  
 habitants of Newcomsted in Cecil County against passing  
 this Bill herewith sent you, and the allegations on both  
 sides seeming very considerable and the case seeming hard  
 on both parties we propose that the consideration thereof be  
 referred till next session and that due notice be given  
 the parties concerned Signed Order John Beale G. Upper House

Which was referred and ordered to be thus returned  
 By the Lower House of Assembly October 21. 1720  
 May it please your Honour? The request is a hard case, on both  
 sides, but much harder on the petitioner Thatcher in whose  
 favour this bill is prepared who since last Provincial  
 Court has been turned out of Posepian his whole (property)  
 and plantation going to ruin and the poor Petitioner's Wife  
 and Children in a perishing condition unless relieved this  
 Session Wherefore for Charity sake we begg your Honours will  
 pass that Bill this Session being fully satisfied with the  
 Justice thereof Signed Order Mr Jemifer G. G. House  
 And was sent to the Upper House by Call. Harman and Mr.
