By the Upper House of Assembly Aug^o 5th 1721
Gent. This Bill will pass with the following Amendments Vizt / and that such Com^{rs} as shall be so appointed shall be enabled to do all things necessary for the doing those Indian Justice against the Trespasser and shall have full power to Com^{and} and obedienc^e from all their: and other persons whatsoever that may be necessary for the determining the said difference and all officers and other persons therewith concerned shall have the same allowance fees and perquisites that are allowed them by Law
