 for paid. Viz. By the lower House of Assembly Oct the 25. 1732.  
 May it please your Hon<sup>rs</sup>. we have read the Allegations  
 of Mayr. Nicholas Sewell in relation to the Land called Daily  
 and Indian Steek. supposed to be included w<sup>th</sup> in the bounds of  
 Indians Land, (and) at present find that only six hundred  
 Acres of Land called Indian Steek, is proved to be within the  
 Indians Land, for which we have agreed with the said (M<sup>r</sup>.  
 Sewell to allow him thirty thousand pounds of Tobacco, (and)  
 to pay him five hundred pounds of Tobacco for his Charges therein  
 that the said M<sup>r</sup>. Sewell is willing (and) ready upon the paying  
 or securing the payment of the Tobacco, to execute a release for  
 the same, to the publick, with which we hope your Hon<sup>rs</sup>. will  
 concur (and) with the payment of the Tobacco.

Resolved per order Mr. J. J. (Stephens),  
 which was sent to the upper House by Mr. B. (Baker) and Mr. C. (Carter),  
 they return (and) say they Deliver to Col. Harwood & Mr. Wright  
 address to the committee.

Proposed by a member (and) Resolved, by the House that the members,  
 that appointed as members of the committee of Aggrievances. have taken  
 well the Character of a committee for Courts of Justice (and) that that  
 Character (and) the Duty of such committee be annexed to the said  
 Committee of Aggrievances as a standing part of their Duty  
 (and) that it be an Instruction to the said Committee of Courts of Justice  
 that they observe the nature of all Commissions of the several Courts  
 of Judicature within this Province (and) that they especially observe  
 any Allegation that may at any time happen by accident or  
 omission or otherwise therein (and) particularly relating to such  
 words. therein as require the several Judges, and Justices to finally  
 determine according to the Laws, Statutes, Ordinances, (and)  
 reasonable Customs of England (and) of this Province or to such other  
 words, as have relation thereto (and) that they shall immediately make  
 a report to the House, of any Allegations that shall at any time  
 happen in such Commissions (and) likewise to have regard, as near  
 as may be to observe wherein they Differ from the forms of the  
 severall Sorts of Commissions to the Judges and Justices in England  
 Likewise Resolved, that it be an Instruction to the said Committee to
