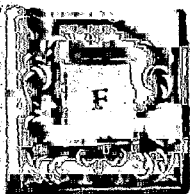

Order'd, That James Harris, Esq; and Mr. John Beale, go and acquaint His Honour the Governour, that a sufficient Number of the Gentlemen, Elected by the severall and respective Counties of this Province of Maryland, to compose a House of Delegates, are convened at the State House. They return and say, they acquainted His Honour therof.

Col. Matthew Wigham Ward, and Benjamin Tasker, Esq; from the Upper House; and George Platt, Esq; Clerk of the Council, came into the Statehouse, in whose Presence the said Return'd Members of the Lower House (except Those that are absent) took the Oaths of Allegiance, to his present Majesty King George the Second, of Abhorrence, and Abjuration, repeated the Test and Sign'd the said Oaths and Test.

Soon after, came the Hon. Philip Lee, and Nicholas Lowe, Esqs; from the Honourable the Upper House, and inform'd the said Representatives, that the Governour required their immediate Attendance in the Council-Chamber: Who thereupon went, and were required by his Honour the Governour, to return to their House, and choose a Speaker. They complied accordingly, and unanimously chose Col. John Mackall (a Member return'd to serve for Calvert County) to be their Speaker: Who in the Chair, and presented him to the Governour in the usual Manner, who approv'd of it. Mr. Speaker made the usual Prolegations to the Governour, in the Presence of all the Members present. Afterwards, Mr. Speaker, with the rest of the Members, return'd to their House, and adjourn'd till to-morrow Morning 9 a Clock.
