

# Notes and Resolves,

OF THE

## Lower House of Assembly, of the Province of MARYLAND.

(Die Sabbati, Octobris 12, 1728.)

**T**HE House met this Day according to Adjournment; the Members were call'd over, and all present as Yesterday, except Mr. *William Hemsley*. Yesterday's Proceedings were Read.

The Commissioners appointed last Assembly, to examine Evidences, relating to the Lands in and contiguous to the City of *Annapolis*, make their Return, and lodge it with the Clerk.

The Engros'd Bill of *John Beale*, of *Charles County*, by the Lower House of Assembly, October 12, 1728. Read and Assented to: And was sent to the Upper House, by Mr. *Samuel Hanson*, and Mr. *Courts*, who return, and say they deliver'd it.

The Petition of *Edward Parish*, of *Anne-Arundel County*, praying Leave to bring in a Bill to enable him to record a Deed, dated the 13th of *August*, 1688. made by *John Waters*, and *Richard Gott*, Executors of *Thomas Pratt*, to certain *Robert Wade*, till now omitted to be recorded, read, and Leave given to bring in a Bill as prayed.

The Petition of *St. Anne's Parish*, in *Anne-Arundel County*, praying Leave to bring in a Bill to make an Assessment for the Reparation of the Church in the said Parish, and building of a Chappel, being read, the Question was put, Whether the Publick should contribute to the Reparation of the Church in *St. Anne's Parish* in *Anne-Arundel County*, and building of a Chappel? Resolved in the Negative: Whereupon the following Endorsement was made, viz.

By the Lower House of Assembly, October 12, 1728.  
Read, and Leave given to bring in a Bill, provided the Inhabitants of *St. Anne's Parish*, bear the whole Charge of Enlarging the Church, as well as Building a Chappel.

*Nicholas Lowe*, Esq; from the Upper House, delivers to Mr. Speaker, the Paper Bill of *John Beale*, of *Charles County*, thus Endors'd, viz.

The Engros'd Bill, whereof this is the Original, is read and assented to, by this House.

*John Beale*, Esq; from the Committee of Accounts, delivers to Mr. Speaker, *John Caldwell's Account*, for Arrears of Rent due to him, for Lands bought by the Country, for the Use of the *Indians*, in Order to have the Directions of the House therein: Which Account being read, the following Endorsement is made thereon, viz.

By the Lower House of Assembly, October 12, 1728.

Which Account being read, it is order'd, That the Committee of Accounts allow the same.

The Petition of *Jonathan Covill*, of *Prince George's County*, praying Leave to bring in a Bill, to confirm his Title to One Hundred Acres of Land, Part of a Tract of Land called *Cheney's Adventure*, lying in the County aforesaid; Read, and Leave given to bring in a Bill according to the Petitioner's Prayer, on proving the Allegations therein contained.

The Petition of the Inhabitants of *Elkridge*, in *Anne-Arundel County*, praying Leave to bring in a Bill to make a new Parish; Read, and granted as prayed; and Order'd, that a Clause be added to the said Bill, to apply Forty Pounds of Tobacco per Poll, due from the Petitioners for this present Year, towards finishing the Church now built.

Col. *Herman*, from the Committee of Elections and Priviledges, makes the following Report, viz.

For *Prince George's County*, Mr. *John Magruder*, Major *Samuel Perrie*, Mr. *Ralph Crabb*, and Col. *Joseph Belt*, we find duely Elected.

For *Anne-Arundel County*, *John Beale* Esq; *Daniel Dulany*, Esq; Mr. *Richard Warfield*, and Mr. *Thomas Worthington*, we find duely Elected.
