For Queen Ann's County, Mr. Augustine Thomsen, Capt. William Blliett, Mr. William Hamfley, and Major William Turbit, we find duely Elected.

For Talbot County, James Holliday, Elq; Mr. George Robins, Mr. Samuel Chamberlain, and Mr. John Edmundson, we find duely Elected.

For Sumelier County Major Robert Kings Lieute Col. Levin Gale, Capit George Dasbiel, and Willi-

am Stoughton, Efq; we find duely Elected.

For Derchester County, Mr. John Brannock, Mr. Peter Taylor, and Mr. John Kirke, we find duely Elected: But the Sheriff hath not complyed with the Duty of his Office, in makeing Return of the Writ of Election according to the Tenor thereof: And we having received a Petition from fundry the Inhabitants of Dorchester County, complaining of the undue Election of Col.
