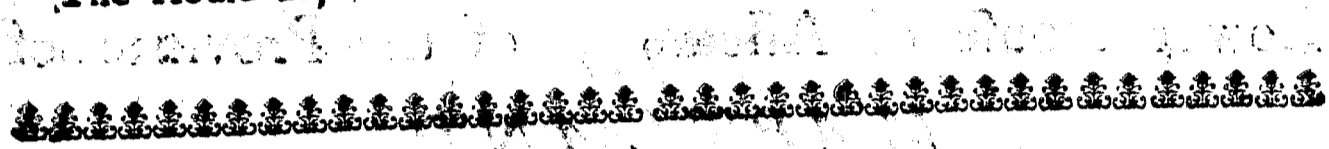


X Charles Calvert, Esq; from the Upper House, delivers to Mr. Speaker, the Paper-Bill, entituled, *An Act to repeal an Act, entituled, An Act prohibiting the Importation of Bread, Beer, &c. from Pennsylvania, &c.* thus endors'd: By the Upper House of Assembly, October 14, 1728.
