Gentlemen,

In Answer to your Message this Day, by James Harris, Esq; and Three more, we have appointed, Col. Richard Tilghman, and Col. Matthew Tilghman Ward, Members of this House, to joyn the Members appointed by your House, in a Conference for settling Officers Fees; who will be ready to attend To-morrow Morning, Ten of the Clock.

The Bill entituled, *An Act for Regulating the several Parishes of St. Mary's and Charles Counties*, being read, was ordered to be thus Indors'd, viz.

By the Lower House of Assembly, October 24, 1728.

Read a second Time, and will pass.

Sent to the Upper House by Major Hanson, and Mr. Young, who return and say they delivered the same.

The Bill entituled, *An Act to erect a Parish in Anne-Arundel County, called Queen Caroline Parish*, was read, and pass'd for Ingrossing.

Mr. George, from the Committee of Laws, delivers Mr. Speaker a Bill entituled, *An Act for the Enlargement of Christopher Bonfield, a languishing Prisoner in Calvert County*, which being read, was ordered to be thus Indors'd, viz.

By the Lower House of Assembly, October 24, 1728.

Read the first and second Time, by an especial Order, and will pass.

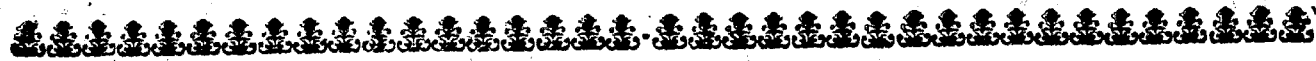
Sent to the Upper House by Mr. Benjamin Mackall, and Major Skinner, who return and say they delivered the same.
