The Petition of the Inhabitants of *Charles County*, was read and granted, according to the Prayer thereof.

The Bill, Intituled, *A Supplementary Act to the Act for Regulating of Writs of Error, and granting Appeals, from and to the Courts of Common of Law, within this Province*, was read the second Time, by especial Order, and was order'd to pass.

Sent to the Upper House, by Messieurs *George*, and *Chamberlain*; who return, and say they deliver'd the same.

The Bill, Intituled, *An Act repealing Part of an Act, Intituled, An Act against Forging and Counterfeiting Foreign Coins, Gold or Silver*; made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the then Town and Port of *Annapolis*, the Twenty Sixth Day of *March*, *Anno Domini 1707*, was read and pass'd, with the Alterations propos'd by the Upper House, for Ingrossing.
