Lower House of Assembly of the Province of M A R Y L A N D.

(Tuesday, July 15, 1729.)

TH E House met according to Adjournment. The Members were call'd over, and all present as Yesterday, except Mr. *John Young*, absent thro' Sickneſs. The Proceedings of Yesterday were read over.

Several of Major *Turbutt's* Family being indispos'd, he, on his Application, hath the Leave of this Houſe to abſent himſelf for ſome time.

On the reading the Report of the Commissioners appointed by the Lower Houſe of Aſſembly, to examine into Two Petitions, (the one preferred by the Inhabitants of the City of *Annapolis*, concerning their Town Commonage; and the other by the Corporation of the ſaid City, concerning the Bounds of the Town-Lands,) *It is Ordered*, That the ſeveral Examinations therein contained, be admitted as Evidence, when the Matter in the Petitions ſhall be heard.

It is the Opinion of this Houſe, That the aforeſaid Two Petitions ought to be deferred, the Heir at Law of Mr. *Bordley*, not being of Age.

It is Order'd, That the Register of the Land-Office attend the Houſe immediately, with the Book wherein the Conditions of the Plantations are collected and recorded, by Order of the Commissioners.

John Rousby, Eſq; from the Upper Houſe, delivers to Mr Speaker, the following Meſſage, *viz.*

By the Upper Houſe of Aſſembly, July 15, 1729.

Gentlemen,

We recommend to your Conſideration, to repeal, or otherwiſe reſtrain the Force of the *Act againſt Forging and Counterfeiting of Foreign Coins, Gold or Silver*, ſo far as relates to Clipping thereof, ſuch being uſeful in Change, ſince the late Regulation of Coin.

The Queſtion being put, Whether a Bill ſhould be brought in, to emit Paper Currency, or not? Reſolv'd in the Affirmative.
