return and fay they deliver'd the fame.

The Bill Entituled, An Act repealing Part of an Act, Intituled, An Act against Forging and Counterfeiting Foreign Coins, Gold or Silver; made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the then Town and Port of Annapolis, the Twenty Sixth Day of March, Anno Domini 1707, was read and pass'd, with the Alterations proposed by the Upper House, for Ingrossing.

The House adjourns 'till To-morrow Morning, at Eight of the Clock.
