

July 14: 1739 Signed by Order of the House for John Mackall, Speaker
Mr. Robert Jordan and Mr. Joshua Gage are Ordered to Acquaint the Governour that
the House hath prepared an Address to him, and Desire to have when and where he will
receive the same, They return and Acquaint Mr. Speaker that they Delivered their
Message and that the Governour made them answer that he would be ready to receive the
same at his House in half an hour

A Motion was made by a Member of this House that the Votes & Resolves of
the Session be printed and the printer Allowed for the same as usual, It was
Resolved in the Negative.

A Motion was made by a Member of this House that a Bill be brought in to
Enable the Justices of Calvert County to Appose a Quantity of Tobacco on the Duties
Inhabitants of the said County, not exceeding ten thousand pounds of Tobacco to be
to pay for the painting the Court House of the said County.

The Petition of the Vestrymen Church Wardens & Parishioners of Westminster
Parish in Annapolis County to the Governour and the Upper & Lower Houses of
Assembly (sent down here from the Upper House) praying leave to bring in a Bill to
Enable them to build a New Church and purchase two Acres of Land just where the
Old School House stood here on Satocke's place formerly kept School to build a
Church on to Enable the Justices of Annapolis County to Appose yearly on the
Taxable persons of said Parish so much Tobacco as will be sufficient to purchase
the said two Acres of Land and build the said Church was read & leave given to bring in a
Bill as prayed.

The Petition of the Mayor Aldermen and Commoners of the City of Annapolis
referred from last Session of Assembly praying leave to bring in a Bill to Empower
them to make a New Road & leave given to bring in a Bill as prayed.

A Member of this House having acquainted the House that the Small pox has raged
in Toppa in Baltimore County where the Court for that County hold that by reason
thereof the last June Court did not proceed to Business that that Distemper still rages in
the Neighbourhood of the said place that the said County Court is appointed by Law
at the first Tuesday in August next by which time there is but very little probability
to hope that that Dangerous Distemper will be so far Abated as to render it safe for a
great Number of people to meet together and that several Members of this House are
Magistrates of the said County and other Members Practitioners in the said Court that
Attendance in this House will not permit them to attend the said Court and moved that a
Bill be brought in to Continue the said Process in the said County till next November next.
Ordered that a Bill be brought in accordingly.

Samuel Dulany Esq. and Tobias other Members are Ordered to Deliver their Address to his
Excellency, They return and Acquaint Mr. Speaker that they Delivered the same
