The Question being put Whether a certain Quantity of Tobacco shall be allowed in each County for the Encouraging the making of Union Cloath in this Province or whether there shall be an Appoinment of price on the Tobacco Inhabitants thereof
Resolved that a certain Quantity be allowed and that the Quantity be two thousand four hundred pounds of Tobacco in each County.

Ordered that it be an Instruction to the Committee in Drawing a Bill that for the best price of twenty Yards of Yard wide Tuen One thousand pounds of Tobacco be allowed for the second pick in Quality of the same Length and breadth Eight hundred pounds of Tobacco And for the third pick in Quality of the same Length and breadth Six hundred pounds of Tobacco And that special regard be had to the Whiteness of the Tuen as well as the fineness and Coarsness of the Thread.
