And Provided, That if the Clearing the said River shall be began within Six Months after the End of this Session, and shall not be compleated, so as to render the said River navigable, according to the Intent of this Act, within Six Years after the End of the said Six Months; that then, and in such Case, this Act shall cease, determine, and become null and void; any thing therein contained to the contrary, notwithstanding.

And the Bill, intituled, An Act to impower the Inhabitants of Anne-Arundel and Prince George Counties, to make the main Branch of Patuxent River navigable, &c. Was sent to the Upper House, by

Mr. Beale, and Mr. Magruder.

Mr. Attorney, from the Upper House, delivered to Mr. Speaker, a Petition of the Freeholders of Cacil County, indors'd. Referred to the Consideration of this House.
