The Conferees nominated and appointed, made Choice of the Honourable Mathew-Tilghman Ward, Esq; for Chairman; and Archibald McPherson, Clerk: And agreed on the following Report.

Your Conferees have taken into Confideration, the Bill for Emitting 72,000 l. in Bills of Credit, Oc. Which requires several Amendments to be made to it: As in Page 1, leaving out a Part of the Preamble, the rest containing sufficient Reasons to support the Bill; to mention the Commissioners, or Trustees, to be Men of Knowledge, Probity, and Fortune.

Pag 2. To add after the Word (Execution) L. 8. And to remove any of them, in Case of Misseburuour or Unstituess to all, suben, and as often as it shall appear to His Lordship, or the Governor, or

Commander in Chief, that the Publick Welfare of this Province so Il require juch Removal.

Your Conferees conceive, that the Sum proposed to be Emitted, will not be sufficient to answer the several Ends for which it is design'd; as will appear by the following Particulars.

Besides, there would be no Part of the Bills of Credit lest, to answer any Publick Charge, how-ever pressing the Occision may be; which your Conferees conceive ought and may be provided for now, with greater falle to the People, by adding to the Sum to be Emitted in Bills of Credit, than by any other Means whitsoever.

Your Conferees therefore propose, that there be a Duty of Fisteen Pence Sterling per Hogshead, and in Proportion forany other Quantity, instead of Twelve Pence; and that there be Emitted in Bills of Credit, a Sum not exceeding, in all
