Your Conferees do also agree, That no married Person shall be liable to be. fold, so discharge all or any Part of bis or their Debts; And we do further propose, that the late Clause in the Amendments be altered; and that instead of the Words, sube shall not make a full and exact Discovery upon Oath, of his or her Debts or Effects; these Words he put in, whoever shall wittingly or willingly neglect to make a full Discovery or true Inventory of his or her Debts or Effects: All which is submitted to the Consideration of both Houses.
