Motion of a Member of this House to Bring in a Bill to Explain  
The Act for the Relief of Adventurers in Iron Works, leave given to bring in a Bill  
Accordingly ordered a Bill to be brought in to revise the Act Entituled an Act

of Peace. Ordered a Bill to be brought in to Explain certain Clauses in the Act
