The Bill Entituled an Act Receiving and Continuing an Act of Assembly of this Province Entituled an Act for the Better Relief of some Debtors Read the Second time, passed and Sent to the Upper House by Col. Ingham and M^r Denton,

The Bill Entituled an Act, Showing and Continuing an Act of Assembly of this Province Entituled an Act, to prevent Cutting up Tobacco Plants &c^o Read the Second time, passed, and Sent to the Upper House by Col. Ward and M^r Hall,

The Bill Entituled an Act receiving and Continuing an Act of Assembly Entituled an Act, for the Speedy recovery of Small Debts &c^o Read Second time / part and Sent to the Upper House by M^r Mathews and M^r Stoughton,

The Bill Entituled an Act for the Building a Court House and Repository for the Records in Leonard Town in St Marys County Read the Second time / passed and Sent to the Upper House by M^r Rice and M^r Jordan

The Bill Entituled an Act for the further restraining the Evil and Fraudulent Practice of Sheriffs Read the Second time and Committed for amendments

The Bill Entituled an Act, to Continue an Act, Entituled an Act for raising a Duty of three pence Shoghead on all Tobacco Exported out of this Province for the uses therein mentioned Read the first and Second time by Special Order, passed and Sent to Upper House by M^r Dulany and five more

A Supplementary Act to the Act, Entituled an Act for the more Effectual Punishment of Negroes and Other Slaves and for taking away the Benefit of Clergy from certain Offenders and to an Act Entituled an Act to prevent the Tumultuous meetings and Other Irregularities, of Negroes and Other Slaves, and Directing the manner of trying Slaves Read the first time and ordered to Lye on the Table
