A Bill for the further Relief of So much money on the Taxable Inhabitants  
In St Marys and Charles Countys, as will build a new Church in that part of the  
Parish which lies in St Marys County and for the repairing of new Court Church  
In the Same Parish, and to appoint a Time for the freeholders, to meet in order to Chuse  
a place to build the said Church upon. Read the first time and ordered to lay on the Table
