On leave given a Bill Entituled an Act to Continue an Act Entituled an Act for raising a duty of 3^d Hoghead on all Tobacco Exported out of this Province for the Use's therein mentioned brought in read the first time and ordered to lye on the Table

On leave given a Bill Entituled an Act Enabling the Commissioners or Trustees of the Paper Currency Office to pay to the Representatives of Several Counties the Sum of five hundred pounds each Brought in read the first time and ordered to lye on the Table

On leave Given a Bill Entituled a Supplementary Act to the Act Entituled an Act to Encourage Adventurers in Iron works brought in read the first time and ordered to lye on the Table

On leave given a Bill Entituled an Act to Cut off the Entail of a Tract of Land containing one hundred and thirty Acres lying in Dorchester County being part of a Tract called Goddridges Choice and to Entail in Lieu thereof a Tract of Land called the Hope containing fifty Acres also another Tract called the Addition to the Hope containing 107 Acres both lying in the said County of Dorchester brought in read the first time and ordered to lye on the Table

On leave given a Bill Entituled an Act to Cut off the Entail of a Tract of Land lying in Dorchester County called Audertons Point containing 100 Acres and to Entail in Lieu thereof 100 Acres of Land lying in the said County being part of a Tract called Richardson's Choice brought in and read the first time and ordered to lye on the Table
