The Bill Entituled an Act for Erecting a Town in Cecil County on the North Side of Sabaspas River &c read second time passed Sent to the Up<sup>r</sup> House by M<sup>r</sup> Johnson and M<sup>r</sup> Wood - Col<sup>l</sup> Ward from the Up<sup>r</sup> House Delivers M<sup>r</sup> Speaker the following Bill, The Bill Entituled an Act to render the Navigation up Patuxent River above Queen Anns Town in Prince Georges County more Easy and Effectual -

The Bill Entituled an Act to Cut off the Letail of a Tract of Land containing One hundred and thirty Acres lying in Dorchester County being part of a Tract of Land called Goodridges Choice and to Letail in Liew thereof a Tract of Land called the Hope containing fifty Acres also another Tract called the Addition to the Hope containing one hundred Seventeen Acres both lying in the said County of Dorchester - The Bill Entituled an Act to Cut off the Letail of a Tract of Land lying in Dorchester County called Ardertons point containing one hundred and Eleven Acres of Land lying in the said County being part of a Tract of Land called Richardsons Choice -

The Bill Entituled an Act for the payment of a Sum of money to Andrew Ramsay and Comp<sup>rs</sup> of Glasgow in the Kingdom of Great Brittain Merchants all severally Indorsed -
