By the up^r House of Assembly 5th May 1736
Gentlemen

Nothing augurs this House Greater pleasure than any Endeavour for, or appearance of Harmony and good agreement between the Two Houses, in this Sight we received your Message of this Day by M^r Hooper & Ward, Burthening it with large Charges by unnecessary Disputes, as on the one hand we have the greatest Satisfaction in being assured that the Honour of Councilors of State will not meet with any Opposition hereafter, & on the other hand we do assure you Gentlemen of no less Joy on our Part, that we will not charge the Country with any Claims since the time of saying the last Publick Debt to this Session
