

The Resolves of the Lower House of Assembly made in the Year 1726 being read are agreed to; except where Alterations are made in them by Congress of Assembly And whereas it is contained in the said Resolves that the Clerk of this House shall sign all proceedings, the Clerk of the House of Delegates, and in other manner, upon which some Disputes have formerly arisen between the Two Houses of Assembly. For prevention of any Disputes which may retard the Dispatch of publick Business, it is resolved, that all proceedings shall be signed by the said Clerk, as Clerk of the Lower House, always saving to the Members of this House and the people they represent and their posterity all their rights and privileges whatsoever; and protesting that those rights and privileges shall not, nor ought to be hurt, prejudiced or lessened by the Clerk of this House his signing the proceedings thereof as Clerk of the Lower House.
