**I** Have therefore thought fit, with the Advice of his Lordship's Council of State, to Prorogue this present General Assembly, and I do hereby Prorogue the same to the second Tuesday in *July* next, being the Eleventh Day of the same Month : And to the Intent that all Persons concerned may have due Notice thereof, I do strictly Charge and Require the Sheriff of the City of *Annapolis*, to make this my Proclamation Publick in his said City, in the usual manner, as he will Answer the contrary at his Peril.
