of State, to Prorogue this present General Assembly, and I do hereby
Prorogue the same to the second Tuesday in July next, being the Eleventh
Day of the same Month: And to the Intent that all Persons concerned
may have due Notice thereof, I do strictly Charge and Require the Sheriff
of the City of Annapolis, to make this my Proclamation Publick in his
said City, in the usual manner, as he will Answer the contrary at his
Peril.
