

VOTES and PROCEEDINGS

Of the Lower House of ASSEMBLY.

Monday Morning, May 7. 1739.

THE House Met according to Adjournment.

Mr. Nicholas Goldsborough, a Member Returned for Talbot County appeared.

Col. Henry Hooper, Mr. Henry Trippe, and Capt. Bartholomero Ennalls, Three Returned Members for Dorchester County, appeared.

Mr. Edward Lloyd, and Mr. Brannock, sent to the Upper House to see them Qualified.

They return, and acquaint Mr. Speaker the said Members were Qualified in the usual manner,

The Gentlemen took their Places in the House.

Ordered, That the Sheriff of Ann-Arundel County produce to this House the Proclamation by which the last Assembly was Dissolved, and that the Clerk acquaint him.

Ordered, That it be an Instruction to the Committee of Aggrievances and Courts of Justice, to Inspect the original Papers, Books, Entries, Records and Registers lodged in the several Offices in this Province, and make Report thereof. And

It is further Ordered, that all Committees Appointed by this House, be Empowered to send for Books, Persons, Papers and Records, and that a Copy of this Order be given to the Chairman of any Committee that shall

Ordered, That the Clerk of the Committee of Laws be allowed a Clerk Assistant.

The House Adjourns to 2 of the Clock in the Afternoon. Post Meridiem.

The House Met according to Adjournment.

Ordered, That a Bill be brought in for the Encouragement of Jonas.
