put, Resolved that Leave be given accordingly.

The previous Question being determined: The Question was put, Whether it shall be a Direction to the Committee for drawing the Bill for Encouragement of such as shall voluntarily Inlist themselves for his Majesty's Service, to Draw the said Bill so as the Money to be applied, be raised by an immediate equal Assessment on the Taxables of this Province, or issued or paid out of the Ossice for Emitting Bills of Credit established by Act of Assembly?

Resolved, That the Money to be applied be issued or paid out of the

Office for Emitting Bills of Credit established by Act of Assembly.

Ordered, That the Address to his Excellency be presented by Mr. Speaker. Mr. Speaker left the Chair, and attended by the Members of this House,

Presented the Address to his Excellency in the Conference Chamber.

Mr. Speaker and the rest of the Members returned. Mr. Speaker reassumed the Chair.

Mr. Moale, Mr. Trippe, and Mr. Edward Lloyd being Absent,

Mr. Thomas Sheredine, Mr. Charles Hynson, and Mr. Grundy Pemberton, added, in their room, to the Committee to Inspect the Accounts and Proceedings of the Commissioners for Emitting Bills of Credit, &c.
