WE herewith send you a Bill, entitled, *An Act for issuing and paying out of the Office of the Commissioners or Trustees for Emitting Bills of Credit established by Act of Assembly of the Province of Maryland, the Sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred and Thirty six Pounds, Sixteen Shillings and Three Pence, Current Money in Bills of Credit of this Province, to be applied for Encouragement of such Persons as shall voluntarily Inlist themselves in his Majesty's Service,* and as his Majesty's Commissions therein mentioned may be hourly expected, we conceive it requisite it should be past into a Law, with all convenient Speed, and therefore perswade ourselves it will find such Dispatch in your House as the nature of the Thing requires.
