At which Meeting your Honourable House judging it necessary for earrying on the faid Addresses, that several Copies of Records from this Province, and other Papers would be wanted, were then pleafed to Order, that Mr. Fames Galder, Dr. Charles Carroll, Mr. Vachel Denton, Capt. Thomas Gassaway, Mr. Philip Hammond, Maj. Edward Sprigg, Mr. Turner Wootton, Mr. Osbern Sprigg, and Mr. John Magrader, Members of the said House, they or the major Part, or any Two of them, should apply to the feveral Officers and Offices of this Province, and demand and take on the Publick Account, Authentick Copies of any Acts of Allembly, Conditions of Plantation, or other Matter or Papers whatfoever, that to the faid Members, the major Part, or any Two of them, should frem necessary and requisite to be transmitted to Great Britain, for the Service of this Province.

That after the House was Prorogued as aforesaid, Dr. Charles Corroll and Vachel Denton, Gentleman, Two of the Members appointed to procure and transmit the Records and Papers as aforesaid, in discharge of the Trust reposed in them, by several Letters directed to Mr. William Ghiselia, Deputy Clerk of the Provincial Court, under Edward Jenings, Esq; Secretary, and to Mr. Gr fith Beddoe, Daputy Register of the Land Office, under Levin Gale, Eig; applied to the faid Clerks for Copies of fandry Records, fuch as they adjudged necessary for the purpose assessid, and were refused the same on the Publick Account; which said Letters and Answers, on the first Day of August last were laid before his Excellency the Governor in Council, at which Board were Prefent,
