They return and acquaint Mr. Speaker the Governor is ready to receive

it immediately in the Council Chamber.

By the Committee of Aggrievances & Courts of Justice. July 23. 1740. Our Committee, upon enquiring for the Commission of his Lordship's Agent within this Province, find, that in the Alphabet of Lib. P. L. Nº 8. Tasker Benj. Agent Commission Folio 300. And on viewing the said Fosio find therein Recorded, a Bond to the Right Honourable Charles Lord Proprietary, dated 12th of Nevember 1734, signed Benj. Tasker, D. Dulany, Geo. Plater, but not the Commission as mentioned in the said Alphabet.

Your Committee humbly conceive, as the said Office of an Agent is a Publick Office with respect to the People and their Interests, the Powers and Authorities by which they Act or have Acted, should be made matter of Record, that hereaster the same may be a justification for Payments made by and for the use of his Majesty's Subjects to such Agents. But the same is humbly submitted to the Consideration of your Honourable

House.
