Collected as aforesaid, according to the Directions of this Act, and no more.

And be it further Enacted, That if the Governor or Commander in Chief of this Province for the Time being, shall not Direct any Arm, Ammunition or other Stores aforesaid, to be Purchased with the Monies arising from the Duties aforesaid, before the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of this Ast, that then the said Money, or such part thereof as shall be unapplied and unlaid out as aforesaid, shall be applied to and for the deiraying the Publick Charge of this Province, as the House of Delegates in such suture Assembly shall direct and appoint.

Provided always, That no hing herein contained shall extend or be construed to extend, to prejudice or take away, any Right or Claim which the People of this Province have or ought to have to any Money or Monies heretofore or now Levied, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, under colour of an Ast of Assembly made in the Year Seventeen Hundred and Four, entituled, An Ast for Settlement of an Annual Revenue upon her Majesty's Governour within this Province for the Time being, or by any other ways or means whatsoever.

This A& to Continue to the 29th Day of September, which shall be in the Year of our Lord 1742, and no longer.

The House Adjourns to the Morrow Morning at 9 of the Clock.
