Resolved by the House, That the Members who are appointed as Members of the Committee of Aggrievances, have likewife the Character of a Committee for Courts of Justice, and that that Character, and the Duty of such Committee, he annex'd to the faid Committee of Aggrievances, as

a flanding Part of their Duty.

And that it be an Infruction to the faid Committee, as a Committee of Courts of Justice, that they observe the Nature of all the Commissions to the several Courts of Judicature within this Province, and that they especially observe any Alterations that may at any Time happen, by accidental Omission, or otherwise, therein; and particularly relating to such Words therein, as require the feveral Judges and Juffices to Hear, Try, and Determine, according to the Laws, Statutes, Ordinances, and rea-Ionable Customs of England, and of this Province, or to such other Words as have Relation thereto, and that they shall immediately make Report to the House, of any Alteration that shall at any Time happen in such Commission, and likewise to have regard as near as may be, to observe rein they differ from the Forms of the several Sorts of Commissions - Judges and Justices in England.
