William Stoughton, Esq; from the Committee of Laws, delivers Mr. Speaker a Bill Entituled, *A Supplementary Act to the Act Entituled, An Act for the Relief of Debtors, and ascertaining the Manner of Tenders in Tobacco; and to the Supplementary Act thereto:* Which Bill was Read the First Time, and ordered to lie on the Table.

The Bill Entituled, *An Act for the better Relief of poor Debtors,* was sent to the Upper House by Wm. Stoughton, Esq; and Mr. Griffith.

Geo. Plater, Esq; from the Upper House, delivers Mr. Speaker the Paper Bill Entituled, *An Act to Enforce the Collection and Payment of the public Charge of this Province, pursuant to an Act of Assembly Entituled, An Act for the Assessment of the public Charge of this Province, &c.* Indorsed, "By the Upper House of Assembly, Septem. 29, 1742." The Ingrossed Bill, whereof this is the Original, is Read and Assented to.
