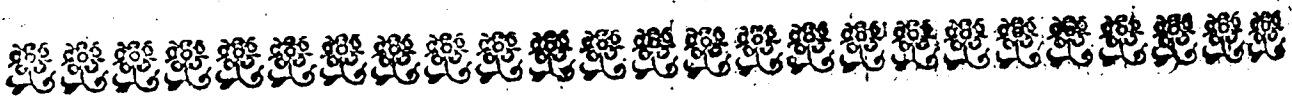
The Bill Entituled, *An Act for the Advancement of Justice*, was read, and, with the Amendments, passed for Ingrossing.

Col. King, from the Committee of Laws, delivers *Mr. Speaker* a Bill Entituled, *An Act to prevent the ill Practices of Sheriffs, in the Collecting and Payment of the Public and County Levies*; which was Read the First Time, and Ordered to lie on the Table.

The Bill Entituled, *An Act to prevent the Exportation of Indian Corn and Wheat, for the Time therein limited*, Sent to the Upper House by *Mr. Waughop* and *Mr. Lecompte*.
