

Saturday Morning, October 16, 1742.

**T**HE House met according to Adjournment. All Members appeared at the Call that were present Yesterday.

On Motion of a Member, that Leave be given to bring in a Bill, to raise a Sum of Money for Support of an Agent for this Province, in *Great-Britain*; Leave is given, and *Ordered*, That the Committee of Laws prepare, and bring in a Bill accordingly.

On Motion of a Member, That *Jonas Green* be allowed a Sum of Money in the Journal of Accounts, for Services done for the Country;

The Question was put, What *Jonas Green* the Printer shall be allowed, in full Consideration of all Services he did for the Country, and Disappointments met with, before the Act passed in his Favour in *July*, 1740, took place? *Resolved*, That the Allowance be 120 *l.* and that the same be allowed in the Journal of Accounts.

On Motion of a Member, that Leave be given to bring in a Bill, to empower His Excellency *Thomas Bladen*, Esq; to purchase Lands whereon to build a House for a Governor; and to Repeal an Act Entituled, *An Act*, &c. Leave is given, and *Ordered*, That the Committee of Laws prepare, and bring in a Bill accordingly.

On Motion of a Member, That Leave be given to bring in a Bill, to continue such Proceſs and Proceedings in the Provincial Court, as will not otherwise continue to another Court; Leave given, and *Ordered*, That the Committee of Laws prepare, and bring in a Bill accordingly.
