And the following Provide to be added, Provided abways, That " any Replevin which shall be iffued out of any County-Count, before the "Said last Day of October, and that Shall not be determined before that Day, Shall and may ha prolegying to final End or Determination, the "Expiration of the said lost Day of October to the contrary not-" withstanding. Signed per Order, J. Ross, Cl. Up. Ho." Which Amendment this House doth not agree to.
