An Act reviving an Act of Assembly of this Province, entituled, An Act for the speedy Recovery of small Debts out of Court before a single Justice of the Peace.

An Act for reviving an Act of Assembly, entituled, An Act for relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggrievances in the Prosecution of Suits at Law, and for reviving and continuing the supplementary Act thereto.

An Act for the Advancement of Justice.

An Act to prevent the Exportation of Indian Corn, for the Time therein limited.

An Act to revive an Act of Assembly of this Province, entituled, An Act for the better Relief of poor Debtors.

An Act to prevent the ill Practices of Sheriffs in the Collecting and Payment of the Public and County Levies.

An Act for the Trial of all matters of Fact in the several Counties where they have arisen or shall arise.

An Act enabling the Justices of Cecil County to levy on the Taxable Inhabitants of St. Mary Anne Parish in the County aforesaid, the Sum of Eight Hundred Pounds.

A supplementary Act to the Act entituled, An Act for repairing the Damages already sustained in the Records of the Land, Secretary's,
